1.0 Invitation

The Vintage Racing Club of BC (VRCBC) is pleased to invite you to participate in the 2021 British Columbia Historic Motor Races (BCHMR) at the Speed-Fanatics Motorsports Circuit in Mission Raceway Park, Mission, BC on August 6 and 7, 2022.

The event is sanctioned by the Confederation of Autosport Car Clubs (CACC), which is affiliated with Groupe de développment sportif/Sports Development Group (GDS), Canada's ASN, under the FIA and is presented with the assistance of the Sports Car Club of BC (SCCBC), the Motorsports Emergency and Turnworkers' Association (META) and other volunteers. Points: The BCHMR is both a VRCBC REVS points and a SOVREN points eligible event.

2.0 Track Information

Mission Raceway Park is located within the City of Mission adjacent to the scenic Fraser River. Mission is approximately 45 miles east of downtown Vancouver on Highway 7; and 10 miles north of the Sumas/Huntingdon border crossing on Highway 11. 3.0 Vehicle Information

Groups: The BCHMR has three race classes plus Novice:

- Closed Wheel: Vintage Group A and Vintage Group B for Production-Based and Improved Production Closed Wheel cars, and approved Exhibition CW cars
- Open Wheel / Sports Racing: Formula Ford, Vintage Purpose-Built OW and SR cars, and approved Exhibition OW / SR cars
- Pacific Challenge Cup (Formula Vee) and OW Novices (Saturday only)
- Novice CW, which runs Saturday only, and may be combined with Group A or Group B CW.

Eligibility: The Supplementary Regulations provide details of group eligibility and related regulations. The final placement of individual racing cars into a specific group will be determined by the organizers according to the number and type of entries received, and other factors.

The VRCBC will make every effort to accommodate unique and significant racing cars. To determine if a vehicle you would like to enter will fit within the groupings and / or regulations, or have other questions, please contact the Event Chairman. (See 4.0 Contacts)

7.0 Social Event

In addition to the racing, there are two special social activities planned for the BCHMR weekend for the enjoyment of entrants, drivers, crew and officials. Both will be held in the large tent at the very west end of the Paddock.

Westwood Reunion Barbeque – Friday August 5 at 5:00 pm

The Westwood Reunion is a recreation of the legendary Saturday night barbeques held for years in the Westwood Clubhouse. The Westwood barbeques were hosted by the Mr. Mike's Steak House chain owned at the time by racer Bob Constabaris. Bob is gone now but his two 'apprentices', Ed Clements and Gio Coletta host the event for all Westwood veterans and anyone else who is interested.

Admission is by donation (\$12.00 minimum please) to cover expenses. Non-alcoholic beverages are included, otherwise BYOB. There is a liquor store (JAK's Beer Wine Spirits) located in the northeast corner of the shopping centre across the highway from the track. There is also a BC Liquor store in the Mission Hills Mall on Lougheed Highway (on the way to the Chevron in Mission).

Traditional Annual VRCBC BCHMR Dinner (may be a Barbeque) - Saturday August 6

One of the highlights of the BCHMR is the traditional Saturday Dinner that features entertainment, awards, the usual 'hard core racer' door prizes and miscellaneous high jinks.

Each entrant will receive a number of tickets in their entry package (as per the order placed with the entry). A limited number of additional tickets will be available for sale at Registration. Entrants are encouraged to pass any unneeded extra tickets to other teams or to turn them in to Registration for sale to others.

The green flag will drop on Happy (half) Hour at 5:00pm with dinner served at 5:30.
