1.0 Invitation

The Vintage Racing Club of BC (VRCBC) is pleased to invite you to participate in the 2025 British Columbia Historic Motor Races (BCHMR) at Mission Raceway Park on August 16-17, 2025. There will also be an open Practice Day on Friday, August 15. The event website is www.bchmr.ca.

The BCHMR is sanctioned by the Confederation of Autosport Car Clubs (CACC), which is affiliated to the Groupe de développement Sportif / Sports Development Group (GDS), which is Canada's ASN appointed by the FIA, and is presented with the assistance of our co-host the Sports Car Club of BC (SCCBC), plus the Motorsports Emergency and Turnworkers' Association (META) and other volunteers. The VRCBC thanks everyone for their assistance.

Points: The BCHMR is a VRCBC REVS **points** and a SOVREN **double points** eligible event.

2.0 Track Information

Mission Raceway Park is located within the City of Mission adjacent to the scenic Fraser River. Mission is approximately 45 miles east of downtown Vancouver on Highway 7; and ten miles north of the Sumas/Huntingdon border crossing on Highway 11. Track information can be found on the event web site.

3.0 Racing Car Groups and Classes

There are three groups with 15 race classes for 2025. The Supplementary Regulations have the details of class eligibility and related regulations. Entrants select their appropriate class from the list of 15 on the online MSReg.com registration form.

- 1. Closed Wheel (CW) Production-Based Racing Cars:** This group has five classes: Vintage CW(A), Vintage CW(B), Vintage CW(C), Sprite-Midget Challenge, and Spec Miata.
- 2. Purpose-Built Open Wheel and Sports Racing (OW/SR) Racing Cars:** This group has eight classes: Vintage OW/SR, Vintage Exhibition OW/SR, all Formula Fords (Club, Modern, Vintage), all Formula Vees (Modern, Vintage) and Legend cars.

3. Novice Drivers: This group has two classes: Novice OW and Novice CW.

Eligibility: The final placement of individual cars into a specific class will be determined by the organizers according to the number and type of entries received, and other factors.

The VRCBC will make every effort to accommodate unique and significant racing cars. To determine if a vehicle you would like to enter will fit within the groupings and / or regulations, or if you have other questions, please contact the Event Chair. (see Contacts below)

4.0 Social Events

There are two social events during the BCHMR weekend for the enjoyment of entrants, drivers, crew, and officials. Both will be held in the large tent at the west end of the Paddock.

'Meet and Greet' Westwood Reunion Barbeque – Friday, August 15, at 6:00 pm

This get together is a recreation of the legendary barbeques held for years in the Clubhouse at Westwood. They were hosted by the Mr. Mike's Steak House chain owned at the time by racer Bob Constabaris. Bob is gone now but his 'apprentices', led by Gio Coletta, host the event for all Westwood veterans and 'younger' enthusiasts. After you have set up your paddock space, come out and meet some of our Westwood veterans and everybody else. Non-alcoholic beverages are included, otherwise BYOB.

There is no cover charge, but a donation (\$20.00 minimum please) is requested. We donate any net amount after expenses to our event charities.

Annual VRCBC BCHMR Dinner- Saturday, August 16, at 6:00 pm

One of the highlights of the BCHMR is the traditional Saturday Banquet. Each entrant will receive their tickets in their entry package (two complimentary plus any extra ordered). A limited number of additional tickets may be available for sale at Registration. Entrants are encouraged to pass any unneeded extra tickets to other teams or to turn them in to Registration for sale to others.

The green flag will drop on 'Happy (Half) Hour' at 5:30pm with dinner served at 6:00.

5.0 Accommodations & Services

Paddock camping is possible, but please be aware that water supply and restroom facilities are limited. Hotel accommodations are available in the City of Mission and the nearby City of Abbotsford.

Restaurant, grocery, liquor store and automotive services are available in Mission and Abbotsford. There is a major regional shopping mall just across the highway from the track.
